



# KNOW BEFORE YOU GO: 2026 IU NATATORIUM INDY SPRING CUP



**NATATORIUM**  
INDIANAPOLIS

- **Venue:** The IU Natatorium – Indy is located on the campus of Indiana University – Indianapolis in downtown Indianapolis. The facility address is 901 West New York Street.
- **Parking:** Spectator and coach parking is in the Natatorium Sports Garage which is attached to the competition venue. Pull into the garage using either the second or third entrance labeled Event Parking or Permit Parking. The cost is \$7 per day payable upon entry by debit or credit card only. Please do NOT pull into the Visitor Section (1st garage entrance) as you will be charged an hourly rate in that section which is considerably more expensive than the \$7 daily rate. Direct entry into the Natatorium is on the first or second floor of the Sports Garage.
- **Pre-Purchased Coach Permits:** Coaches who pre-purchased parking permits through OME can pick up their permits at Team Registration on the upper level of the Natatorium. Upon arrival, drive into the first garage entrance and pull a ticket. Swipe the permit received at registration to exit. After your first arrival, please use only the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> garage entrances to access the Sports Garage. Swipe or scan the permit for each entry.
- **Arena Construction & Road Closure:** With the construction of the James T. Morris Arena on Ohio Street, the Natatorium Sports Garage is only accessible using Blake Street off of New York Street. You will not be able to access the Sports Garage using Blackford Street (Blackford is the street that borders Military Park) because Ohio Street is closed behind the Herron School of Art. (See Parking Maps on Event Information Hub)
- **Team Registration:** Upon arrival at the Natatorium, coaches should proceed directly to Team Registration to pick up their team's credentials and other important meet information. Registration will be located on the East Concourse on the upstairs level of the facility. Signage will direct coaches to the Team Registration area. No deck entry will be granted without an event credential.
- **Tickets:** All tickets to this event are electronic and sold only online. Fans are advised to purchase their tickets prior to arriving at the Nat at <https://am.ticketmaster.com/iuindy/buy/26-indy-spring-cup>. While there will be a ticketing Help Desk on the main concourse at the Natatorium, there will be no onsite sale of tickets. Upon arrival, spectators will need to present their electronic tickets to obtain a wristband at the ticketing Help Desk. The wristband is used for in-and-out privileges into the spectator seating galleries. Fans who purchased an all-session ticket will be given an all-session credential at the ticketing Help Desk upon arrival that allows entry into all meet sessions. Coaches and athletes can access the spectator galleries throughout the week by presenting their event credentials.
- **Seating:** There is spectator seating on both sides of the IU Natatorium in either the east or west seating galleries. All seating is General Admission, first-come, first-served.
- **Volunteer Team:** An economical way to attend the meet is by serving as a member of the volunteer team. In addition to having the best seats in the house, all volunteers receive complimentary parking and meals during their shifts plus a commemorative meet t-shirt. - **Event Vendor:** Purchase your all of your meet supplies by visiting Elsmore Swim Shop, the official event merchandise vendor, on the main concourse of the Natatorium. Hours are Thursday from 8:00 AM – 12:30 PM; Friday from 8:00 AM - 12:30 PM & 5:00 PM - 7:00 PM; and Saturday from 8:00 AM – End of Prelims.
